

From Baroque to Rock

Arrival

Please enter Kensington Palace Gardens via the **Gate next to The Orangery** (see map overleaf). These gates will be open from 18.30 and the gig will begin at 19.30.

Please note your ticket does not include entry to Kensington Palace as this event takes place outdoors on the **Orangery Lawn in Kensington Palace Gardens**. If you would like to visit the Palace, you can purchase an admissions ticket online or on the day. The Palace is open daily 10.00-18.00. This event is inspired by our *Enlightened Princesses* exhibition which you can visit when you purchase an admissions ticket.

Seating

Guests will be able to sit on the Orangery Lawn (grass) so please bring a blanket/cushion to sit on. Please do not bring folding chairs/stools as this will obscure the view for other guests. There will be cushions available to hire on-site for £1.50 each (cash only please).

Weather

The event will go ahead even if it rains so please bring waterproof clothing.

Refreshments

If you have pre-ordered a picnic box, you will be able to pick this up on arrival. There will be food/drink to purchase on site but you are also welcome to bring your own picnics (no glass please). You may be subjected to a bag search by our security team in the interest of public safety.

21:30 Gates close

By car

There is no parking available at Kensington Palace. There is a 24-hour Euro Parks car park on Bayswater Road, approximately 10 minutes' walk from the palace. There is also an NCP Car Park located on Young Street, off Kensington High Street. It is approximately 20 minutes' walk.



By underground

District or Circle lines to High Street Kensington (approximately 15 minutes' walk)

Central Line to Queensway (approximately 15 minutes' walk) or Notting Hill Gate (approximately 25 minutes' walk).

By bus

Bus routes: 70, 94, 148, 390 to Bayswater Road or 9, 10, 49, 52, 70, and 452 to Kensington High Street.

By bicycle

No cycling is permitted within Kensington Palace Gardens. However bicycles may be left in the racks outside the Orangery, at the owner's risk.
