Hampton Court Palace:

One of our knowledgeable and qualified Deaf BSL-using Guides or BSL Interpreter-Guides will be available to help you explore the stories of Hampton Court Palace on the following dates:

The Deaf Guides will give guided tours of the palace at 10:30-12:30, 13:30-15:30 (and 16:00-17:00 summer hours only).



BSL interpreters will be available all day to interpret the palace's daily, timetabled, costumed presentations and facilitate conversations with the staff.

BSL tours start from the Information Centre off Base Court, which is where you will find the Deaf Guide or BSL Interpreter. Our Deaf Guides wear a purple sash with 'Deaf Guide'on; our BSL interpreters wear a purple tabard with 'BSL interpreter'on the back.

Mixed deaf and hearing groups or families can ask for an interpreter to accompany the Deaf Guide on the day of their visit to Hampton Court as long as it is booked at least 15 days in advance (due to the availability of the interpreters).



Tower of London

A knowledgeable and qualified BSL interpreter will help you discover a thousand years of history at this ancient and powerful fortress. The BSL interpreter will meet you at the Welcome Centre at 10:30 and 14:00 on selected dates

Our BSL interpreter will be wearing a bright blue high-visibility vest with 'BSL interpreter' on the back.

A BSL interpreter is available once a month on specific dates and will follow the Tower's daily guided tours, any historical re-enactments as well as visit any other attractions within the Tower.

Banqueting House, Whitehall

Join our BSL interpreter in the Main Hall of Banqueting House to learn more about the history of this magnificent building.

Our knowledgeable and qualified BSL interpreter will be in the Main Hall from 11:00 to 13:00 on the following Saturdays:

4 July 2020

Our Hidden History talk (with BSL interpretation) will start at 11:30. The talks last about 10-20 minutes and the topic varies each month.

At other times between 11:00 and 13:00, the BSL interpreter will be available to interpret questions and the Handling Collection.

When you arrive in the Main Hall look for our BSL interpreter, who will be wearing a purple vest with 'BSL interpreter' on the back.

Kensington Palace

BSL-interpreted tours are available on request for the King's State Apartments or Victoria: A Royal Childhood. Each tour takes around 1½ to 2 hours.

They must be booked at least 15 days in advance so that we have time to check the availability of our knowledgeable and qualified BSL interpreters.

Kew Palace

BSL-interpreted tours with our knowledgeable and qualified BSL interpreters can be arranged on request with at least 15 days notice.
